Sorry, omitted this one:

Development must be carried in a strictly controlled manner to ensure that contaminants are not exposed, nor releases allowed to air, land or controlled waters, which could cause pollution, harm or nuisance. Clearing areas, particularly removing hardcover, must be done in a manner not likely to expose contaminants to flushing by incipient rainfall or surface water run-off on the site. Temporary surface water controls and management of any materials movement on site is critical to ensure protection of controlled waters near the site, in particular at the cable landfall location.
